

As promised, our church family will be gathering together beginning Sunday, August 1! However, in order to do so, the following minimum standards must be in place...at least in the beginning.

1. If you have any of the following symptoms, please remain home and join us for church service by way of the weekly Sunday service livestream.
 - a. Fever or chills
 - b. Persistent coughing
 - c. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - d. Fatigue
 - e. Muscle or body aches
 - f. Headache
 - g. New loss of taste or smell
 - h. Sore throat
 - i. Congestion or runny nose
 - j. Nausea or vomiting
 - k. Diarrhea

NOTE: Some of these symptoms could be from exercise, allergies, or just a part of your everyday life. It is up to you to let us know.

2. Bro. Pat Hamel will greet everyone at the door to the church building. Part of his duties will include opening and closing the outer door. This will limit the amount of time for cleaning, as doorknobs will have to be cleaned after anyone touches them.
3. Sis. Faith will be at a table just outside the door to the sanctuary. She will be taking your temperature before you can enter. If your temperature is above the normal body temperature, (by age) you will be asked to step outside for a few minutes, after which, Sis. Faith will be happy to retake your temperature. If it is still above the acceptable range, please return home and view the church service by way of the weekly Sunday livestream. She will, also, be asking you if you have any of the symptoms listed in statement one.
4. Please bring a facemask with you. Facemasks are required if the required six-foot social distancing cannot be maintained. Some will choose to wear the masks while in the building and some will not. Please respect their choice. However, if the six-foot distance is being broken, wear the mask. This includes going from your vehicle to the building and back to your vehicle from the building. Please maintain the six-foot distance.
5. The seats in the sanctuary are set up to provide the minimum social distancing requirement. They have been set up for singles, couples, and families. Please do not move these chairs

around. If we have erred in setting up enough chairs to accommodate your presence, we will be happy to right this wrong.

6. Once you have taken your seat, please stay seated. Moving around the sanctuary will, eventually, break the social distancing expectation. It will be up to you to keep watch over your children. Children will be children and are likely to wander. There is no need to be agitated and act like a school hall monitor, whisk them up, and plunk them into a chair. Treat this as a time for them to learn the special behavior expected in the church building. No problem!
7. Before and after service, remain in your chairs for fellowship. Immediately after service, I will sit on the platform and fellowship with you. We can use this time to ask and answer questions you may have concerning the church service, the lesson/sermon, questions you may have concerning the safety requirements, suggestions on better doing what we are doing, or just fellowshiping with each other...at a distance.
8. If you use the lavatory, there will be cleaning supplies available to clean up after yourself. If your child/children use the lavatory, whomever is responsible for them must make sure it is clean. In addition, hands must be washed and hand sanitizer used after using the lavatory.
9. Musicians and song leaders will be responsible for cleaning their areas and equipment. They will also stay in the music area during the preaching/teaching.

I know this is a lot to digest, especially, when we have never had to do this. But please do me a favor and **not** look at the above expectations as rules and regulations. Instead, look at them as another way of doing what we have always done, but in such a way as to do our share to help everybody feel safe and so we can keep on meeting together as the Apostolic Cornerstone Church family.

As part of our gathering together, we are required to have no more than twenty-five percent capacity, or less in the sanctuary seating area, follow the state's mandatory health and safety guidance, and keep the expected distance between people—a minimum of six feet. This is why we have to meet in groups. The objective is to make a way available for everybody in this church to gather together for church service and stay within the governmental guidelines for safety.

Please keep in mind that it is not the church's responsibility to provide rides. Try to work out transportation on your own. If you cannot find transportation, let me, my wife, or any of our licensed minister know and we will be happy to try to help you find your way...this is what good "shepherds" do.

In advance, I thank you for your cooperation. In the future, as the government continues to "turn the spigot" and the expectations ease up, we will tweak the service groups until we reach the point where

we no longer need to have maximum number limitations. Until then, I welcome you back and look forward to being with you as we celebrate the Lord and Builder of the Church, Jesus!
